


# Measures for visiting showUP in a safe manner

## General



Stay home if you or your housemates have symptoms of disease.



Social distance. Always keep 1,5 meter distance to eachother.



Avoid physical contact like shaking hands and hugging.




Use the sanitizers placed on the exhibition floor and near toilets.




Wearing a facemask is NOT obliged. Facemasks are available at the entrance if you want to wear one.



Extra hygienic measures are taken in toilets and contact surfaces.



The climate system of the Brabantallen guarantees good ventilation and a continuous supply of fresh outside air.



To spread visitors and to avoid crowds we ask visitors to register for a specific day and timeslot.


## Before visiting



Always register beforehand and online. You can NOT register at the door. Choose a timeslot. You can visit showUP between 09:00-13:30 or between 14:00-19:00.



Prepare your visit prior to the event via [www.showup.nl](http://www.showup.nl) so that you can spend your time efficiently. Plan the route you want to take at the floor. The floorplan and exhibitor list are online. TIP: make appointments with you favourite suppliers.



One day before your visit you will receive an e-mail with protocols and regulations. After filling in the health check form you can download and print your access badge.





On the day of your visit you bring the printed access badge. Come by car if possible. Follow instructions at the venue.




## While visiting



Visit showUP in the timeslot you booked. Take hygienic precautions and always keep 1,5 meter distance.



There is a self service cloakroom at the entrance. After you scanned your badge you will receive a keycord. TIP: Leave your coat in the car when the weather allows it.



The extra wide aisles provide plenty of space to keep distance and visit the exhibition in a relaxed way. Maintain a logical walking route, keep right and look right.



In the booths also keep 1,5 meter and avoid physical contact. Unfortunately, shaking hands, hugging and kissing are still not allowed.



At the foodcourts all items are sold pre-packed. You can only pay with a card and eating and drinking is only allowed when sitting.
